"BIG JIM-LITTLE JIM", "JAKE AND DAISY DEW", "MAW-PAW" ... who were these names from the past, and just how did they find their place in history by appearing on a citrus soda in the familiar green bottles called Mountain Dew?

"ONE THAT'S ABLE, SAYS MABLE" certainly makes you wonder who Mable was and what she was able to do! Such is the nature of the mysteries surrounding the Mountain Dew soft drink bottles that were filled from the early 1950's to the late 1960's.

The names listed to follow have been cataloged from several collections and are to be found in bold white letters on the middle face of the front bottle label.

One might speculate that the names represent employees of the bottling companies or thier kin. Prefixes such as "Bottled by", "Filled by" "Capped by", and "Jugged by" would support this theory.

Many unanswered questions remain ... "How were the names choosen", "How many bottling companies participated", and most intriguing, "How many different names are just lying around to be collected"?
