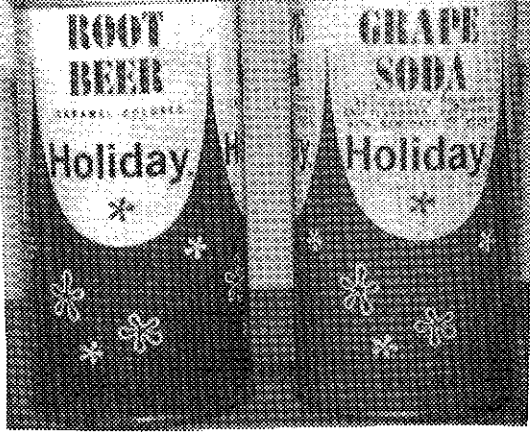

Perrier has introduced an 11.2 ounce can for airline use, and according to the company this is not a development to be taken lightly. You see, Perrier has drawn its famous elixir from a single spot in the French countryside for over 100 years and, in the words of the noble bottler itself, "Change does not come easily to these environs, and so too Perrier's distinct green, club-shaped bottle



has not changed since it was first designed 120 years ago." Now the company has gone ahead and packaged its sparkling waters in an aluminum can for inflight use. What's the reason behind this — as Perrier calls it — "drastic step"? The answer is simple: the product's unflagging popularity. "Airlines have recognized a preference, especially among frequent flyers, for a refreshing beverage like Perrier that contains no alcohol, no calories, and no caffeine," says Kim E. Jeffery, Perrier's vice president, sales, "and they have urged us to develop a can for inflight service."

The end result retains both Perrier's traditional green packaging and, because it is printed in both French and English, its continental allure. To satisfy contemporary standards, however, it is outfitted with an ecology top. Cases are shrink-wrapped for 24 loose cans and, made in lightweight aluminum, weigh but 18.6 pounds.

## Royal Crown buy disputed

NEW YORK (AP) — Financier Victor Posner, who has offered to buy Royal Crown Co. Inc. for \$40 a share, filed suit to block a rival \$37-a-share bid from three Royal Crown directors.

Royal Crown had said earlier this week it agreed to be acquired by Peachtree Holding Corp., which owns about 18 percent of the soft-drink concern's 8.2 million common shares outstanding and is controlled by the three directors. That offer is valued at about \$249.4 million.

**Cola charge:** A consumer group has charged that makers of some diet colas that use the new sweetener Nutrasweet are misleading the public by not pointing out that the products also contain saccharin. The Center for Science in the Public Interest said ads for Diet Coke, Diet Pepsi and Diet Rite colas are "deceptive and potentially dangerous" because they don't mention saccharin.

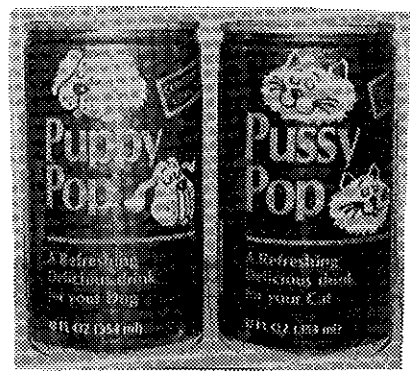

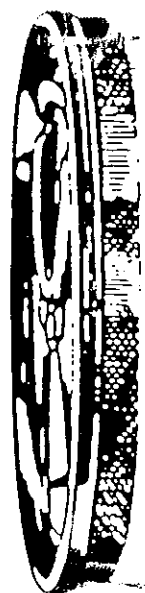

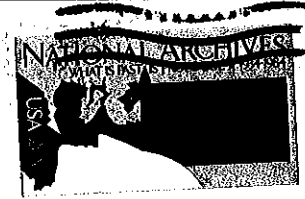
