

DUMPING, SIGHT SEEING, CONVENTION, & MORE DUMPING.....

It's been a long hot summer in these parts and rather dry. I been working 7 days a week most of the year, but put my vacation time to good use. I took two weeks off for an International dumping trip in August, when a collector friend of mine from Holland came to the U.S.A. just to go dumping with me. He, by the way has started a BEER & POP can club in Holland and the hobby is really catching on. He tells me there is almost as much interest in pop cans as there is in beer cans.

Getting back to my story, 4 of us went dumping for a week in the north woods. I had been planing this trip for over a year, so I had a fresh area all picked out. We pitched a tent and did our own cooking to keep expences down. We had a great time and we found cans every day. Of the 7 days of dumping we found 4 major dumps and the other 3 days we found enough small dumps to make it interesting. This trip I might add had more than the normal amount of good POP cans, and since our Dutch friend Wout Arentzen knows pop can collectors in Holland too, we picked up afew more pop cans than we normaly would. Acouple of them I could not recall ever seeing before, but then I'm sure there must be hundreds I have never seen before. Never the less they excited me, finding a can I never seen before be it beer or pop is the biggest thrill of a hunt. Diet Dads root beer and a odd color Dads regular Root Beer (Silver, blue, & white) both are punch tops. In all we brought back about 1200 beer cans and 100 pop cans.

September is the month of the big BCCA Beer Can convention. This year it was in Houston. 4 of us chose to drive instead of fly down. We took two wees and pland to do some dumping going & coming back, plus see some of the country we never been in before. In all we drove through 11 states and did alittle dumping in all of them. Having never been in a number of them before we didn't know what to expect, and like I've always said, you do better when you know the terrain. We found little in most states, but it was an expirence we all enjoyed. Our best luck going was in Louisiana, and coming back in Arkansas. We picked up a total of about 350 beer cans and only 3 pop cans, two nice Golden Age root beer flats, and one tab I had to take, it's called Dr. Nut, has a picture of a squirrel and a walnut on the can. It's a tab, not that old, but another first for me.

Some of the high lights of the convention was getting to meet afew of NPCC's finest members, Carr Sutter, Ed Ewell, & Warren Hardaker. I don't think there were as many pop cans at this convention as there were last year, but still seen some nice ones on the trading floor.

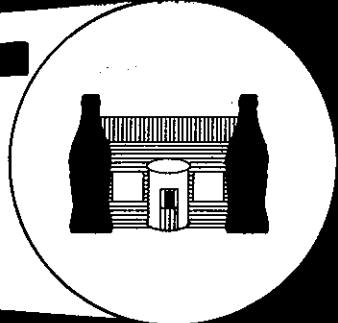

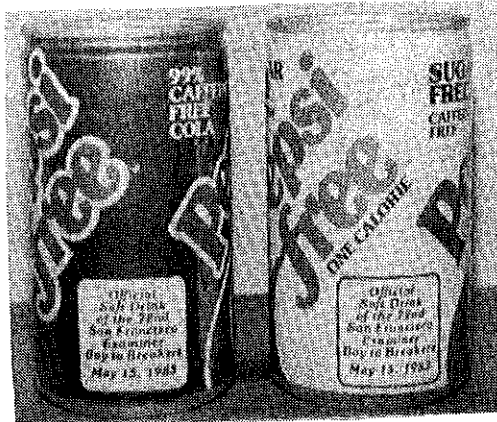
