



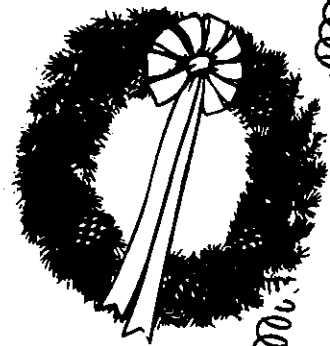

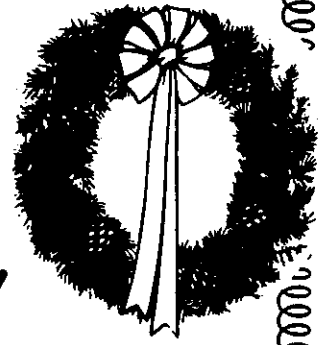

SODA CAN COLLECTING IN ARIZONA

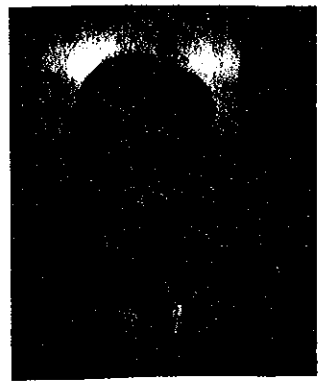
I started collecting soda cans ten years ago. I became interested in them when a friend of mine asked me to go with him to an old ghost town about fifty miles from Tucson. In order to get to the town named Oro Blanco we had to use my friends four wheel drive vehicle as there was eight miles of terrible road to travel. It took us about an hour and a half to go the eight miles. Actually at the old town site we didn't find much so we drove about another mile farther down the road when we noticed two old abandoned adobe houses from which the inhabitants had left years back. In one of the houses in the living room there were piles of empty cardboard boxes, newspapers, magazines and other paper material. I dug into the piles of old newspapers and buried underneath them I came across numerous C & C cone top cans twenty two in all and in Grade #1 condition. The first can I picked up was a Super Coole Pineapple flavored. Other flavors I found were Black Cherry, Root Beer, Orange, Lemon Lime, Cola and Ginger Ale.

So deciding to collect cans I did a lot of hunting in earnest going to other ghost towns looking for dumps and empty houses. I concentrated mostly on cone tops and flat tops and have found for my collection quite a few prize cans. Another source of obtaining good cans I attend flea markets and garage and yard sales. At a Phoenix flea market a couple of years ago there was a Pepsi cone top with pictures of the Pepsi cap around the side of the can and it was almost in mint condition. I asked the fellow behind the table how much he wanted for it and he said Fifty Cents. That is one of my prizes in my collection plus a mint Queen O. Other cone tops I have to name a few are Bala Club, Donald Duck, Cliquot Club, Franks, Jic Jac, Ma's Root Beer, Twang plus others. I also have a few Canadian such as Export, Pure Springs and Uptown. I have found the C&C in 9oz in Ginger Ale and Root Beer flavors. I have numerous 6oz cans also, I have eighty five cone tops in Grade #1 and 2 in my collection.

In flat tops I have found at ghost towns and dumps such brand names as Alaska All Grape, Bala Club, Big Deal, Belfast, Big Vic, Columbine, Cactus Cooler, Donald Duck, Kewpie, Pabst 10oz, Roy Rogers & Dale Evans, Pic A Pop, Tops'n Pop, Top Treat just to name a few. My flat top collection consists of 250 cans mostly in Grade #1 and 2 condition.

I did also collect pull tabs but had to give up on them due to shortage of space. Collecting old cone tops and flat tops is a challenge as they are getting so hard to find. But going to old ghost towns is exciting and most always quite rewarding.

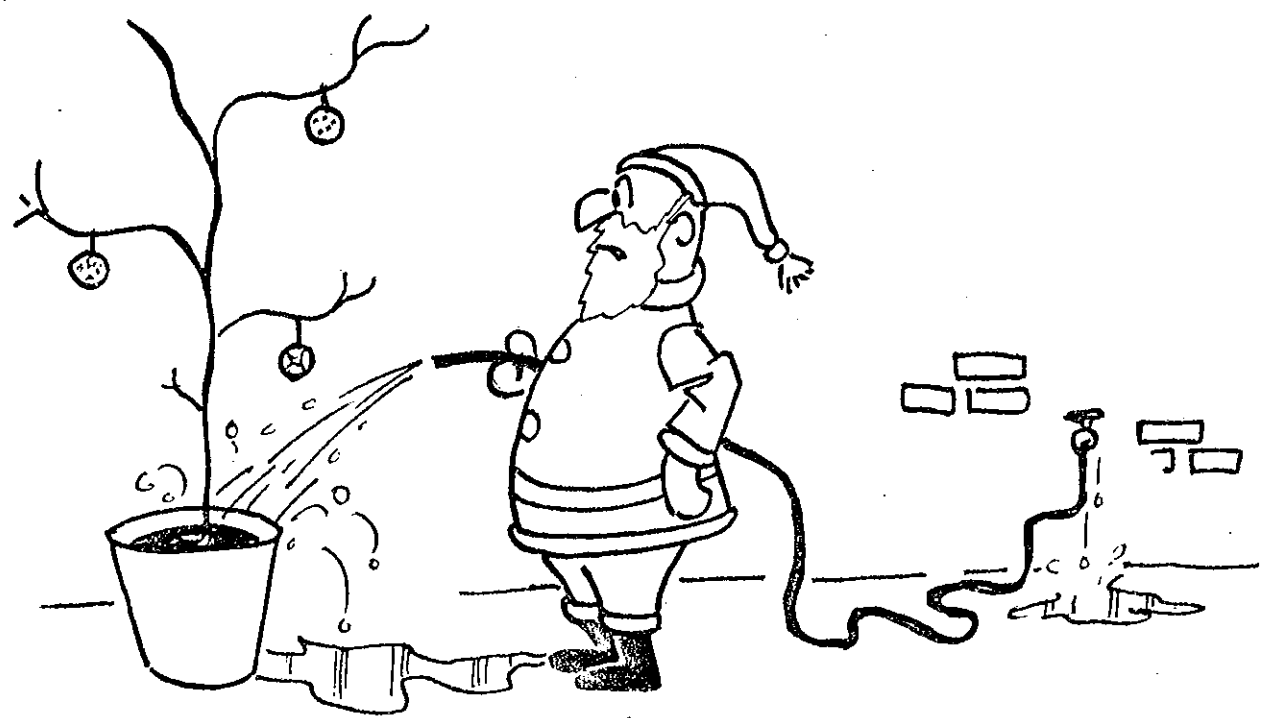
service after 32 years of service. I am President of both the Greenview and Sexton Cemetary Associations here in Fairmount Illinois. This is almost a full-time job during the grass growing months each year. I have been collecting cans and associated items since 1977. It all started with dumping for bottles and my deciding to collect everything else that went along with the hobby. So I dug out many unusual cans and also salvaged all good beer cans that I found too. I have spent many hours on my frequent trips to the West digging in dumps and hunting roadsides. This has added many cans both soda and beer to my collection plus a number of bottles I would not have gotten otherwise. Belonging to NPCC has brought me many new friends each and every one of whom I appreciate very much. I have perhaps 4000 soda cans, 450 soda bottles, 60 beer bottles and about 700 beer cans. My tastes run to the older cans, but I have many, many of the newer ones and I never turn down a nice recent or new issue. I usually make a point to stop at all rest areas while traveling and take a quick peek in the dumpsters or the other trash recepticles. This normally pays off in some unusual cans.

This is a short critique on a recent dumping trip to a favorite area about six miles from Fairmount.

From the road it is about a half mile walk with sacks, digging rakes, shovels and a can of Deep Woods Off insect repellent to keep off the sand fleas and mosquitos which have been unmerciful this season. I had this dump pinpointed from my last dig in this area about 2 years back. This was another of those old dumps on a bluff near an old coal mine. Collectors items I found at this location included 2 six ounce amber ACL bottles, Dr Enough-which I have never heard of before now, a flat top Canfields cherry-ola, a Huber beer can, about 30 Howdy "the friendly drink" cans in root beer and orange, several Metrical cans in various flavors and a large Motts AM 5 flavor fruit drink along with a Sego in butter pecan flavor, another new one for me. All in all, I certainly enjoy "My Goodies and Garbage".
