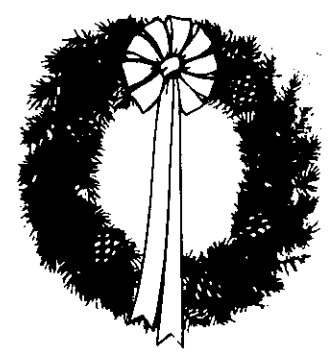

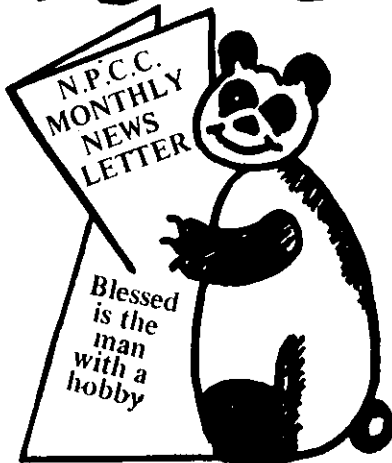

Recently, myself and two friends spent about six hours excavating in an old abandoned dumping area near what was once the old Central Coal Company. This mine was in active operation in the 30's thru the 50's. As the trucks would come to get a load of coal they would bring a load of refuse and dump it in a hollow on the hillside. This type of dumping and pick up operation went on from the early 40's to the late 50's. This made this particular site a better than average one for us "dumpers" as there is no layer of recent junk to contend with. All materials here predate tab tops. We were fortunate enough to dig out hundreds of old cone top beer cans, a few that will possibly clean up to be collectable. Also hundreds of flat top beer cans, some unusual cans.

We found an old Mission root beer with diagonal stripes, many Pabst flavors in the 10 oz cans and several 12 oz Tap-A-Colas. We also salvaged numerous other utility items such as salt and pepper shakers, still full, old ash trays, marbles, drinking glasses, dishes, granite ware, eating utensils, old medicine bottles, wine bottles and one of our greatest thrills was a large number of unusual soda bottles. Most of which we had not remembered as seen before.

These are some of the bottles we came home with;

Many of these bottles are embossed, some are enameled. We carried home bushels of them. A thoroughly enjoyable experience.

Apple Brau was canned by the Graf's Company of Milwaukee (recently sold to the Canada Dry Corporation), there were three variations, all obsolete.

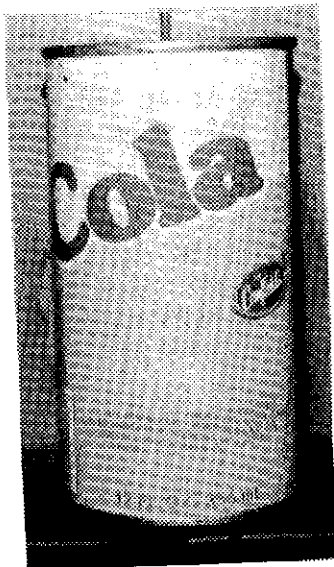
Yummy distributed an apple beer, Cott had made an apple ginger

beer. A few other apple sodas that were on the grocers shelves were Apple Nocker, Apple Sidra, Apple Snap, Apple Up, Apple Jackie and Aspen. Packaged also by the Fairmont Apple Beer Cannery is a cherry beer. Many foreign countries sell ginger beer rather than ginger ale as we know it.

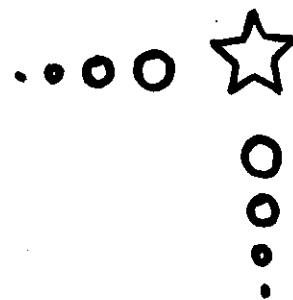
This again is only a small portion of the fast growing soda can collecting hobby. Try us, you'll like us. *

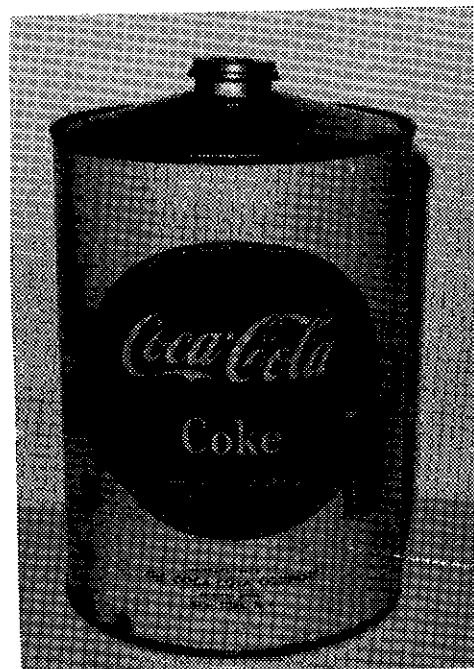
