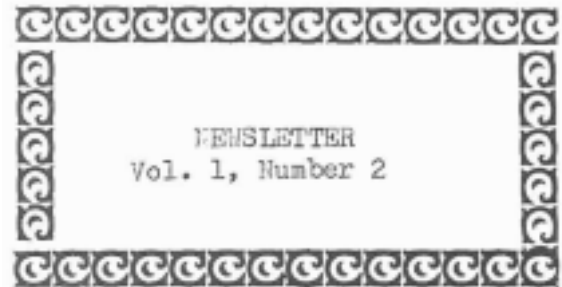


NATIONAL POP CAN COLLECTORS

That is a very good question, because most root beer collectors have a different reason.

Some collectors only collect certain brands. For example some collectors only collect pepsi cans, You would really be surprised how many pepsi cans there has been through the years. And that included such pepsi cans as the Denver Nuggets.

Some collectors only collect punch top coda cans (that is the type you need a can-opener in order to open.) Some only collect cans from their state. Some only collect cans with pretty pictures on them.

How you collect your soda cans is your decision. Just make sure you collect them the way that interests you the most, and don't worry about how someone else does it and you will be sure to enjoy your personal collection. We have found that if you start collecting the way someone else does it without really liking it that way yourself, it won't be long before you lose interest in collecting in any fashion.

In summary, most collectors collect all coda cans, however some specialize. But whatever way you collect make sure it is a way that is special to you and you will enjoy the hobby for a long, long 'time.
