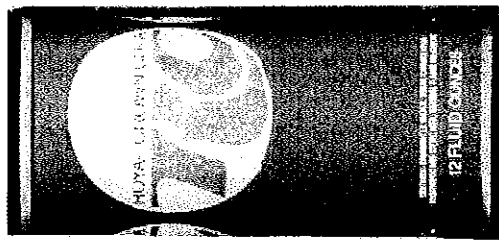
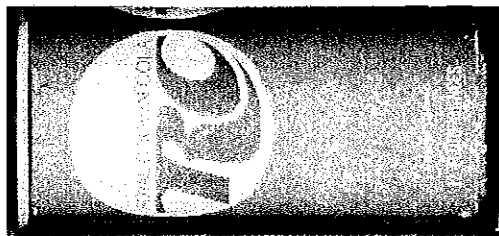

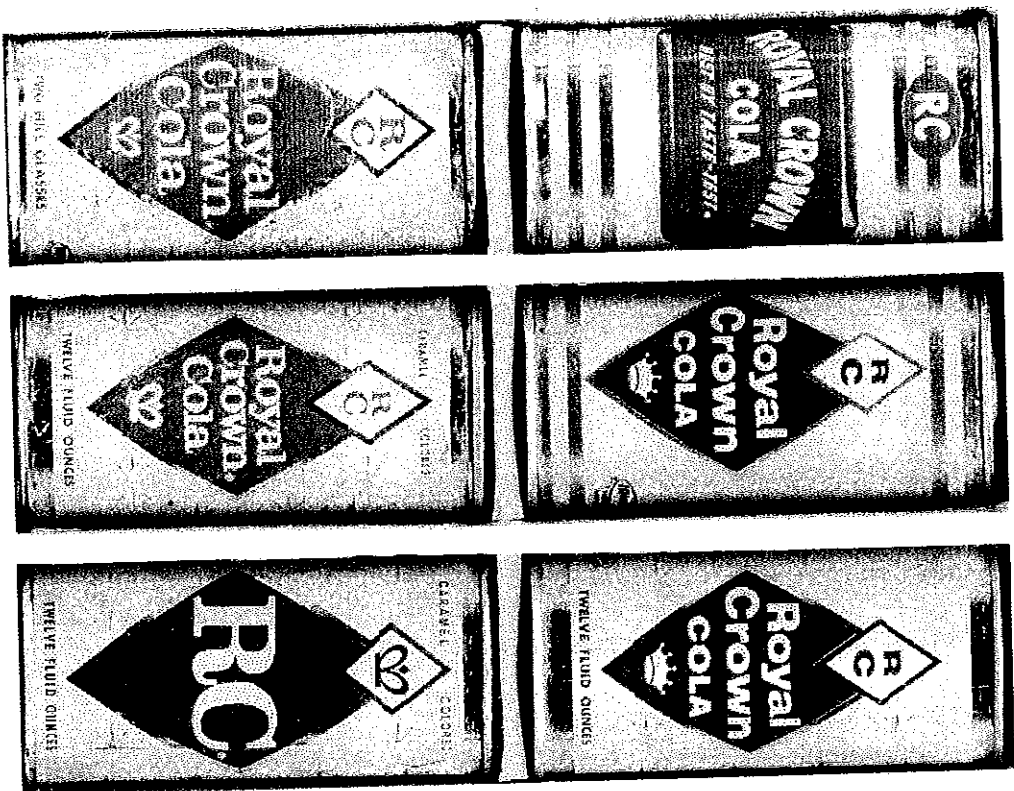

A Coca-Cola short story. On the front cover is the latest in 8 oz cans from Coca Cola. On the back cover is a range of cans which began in the 1970's. The earliest marked 8 Fl Oz is aluminum. This was followed by cans marked 8 FL OZ 236 ML. These steel and aluminum versions are followed by two different Non-Detachable Lift Top Lid cans and a can marked for Passover. The 1985 "NEW" banner Coke can is probably the hardest of the small cans to find. "NEW" Coke didn't last to long before Coca-Cola Classic was brought back. Since then the company has redesigned their logo twice....the bottle design and now the bottle cap design both marked 8 FL OZ (237 ML).

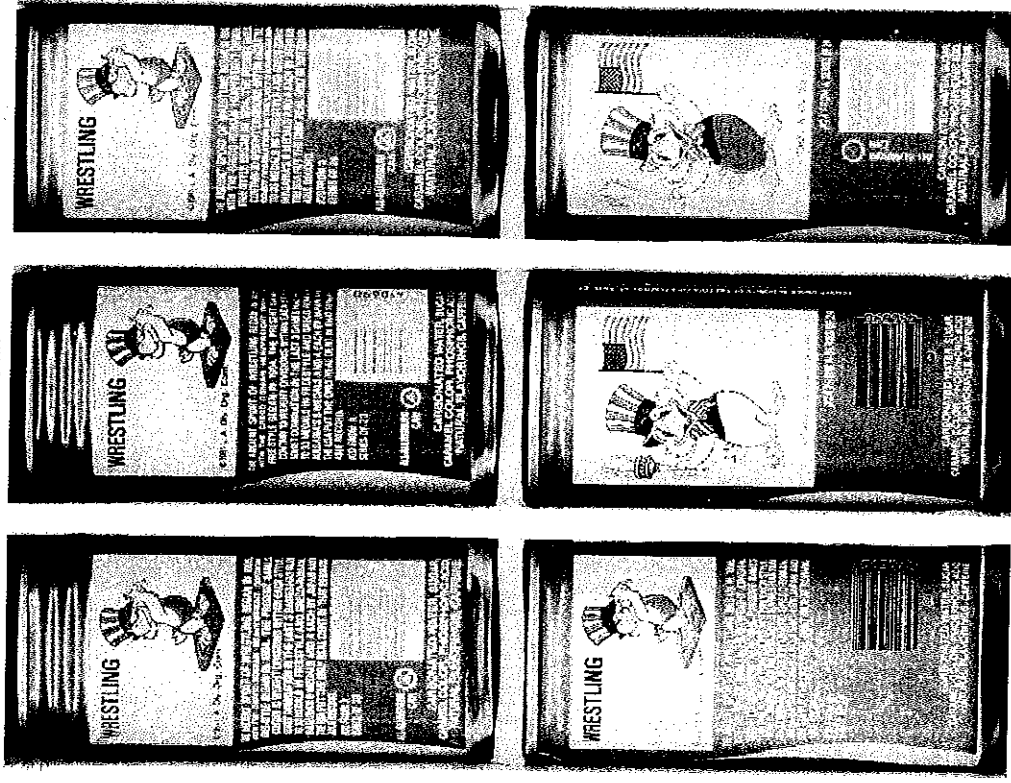
