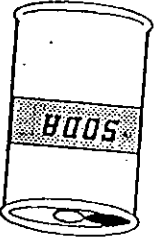


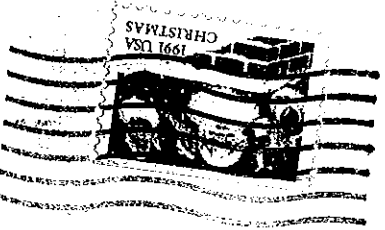

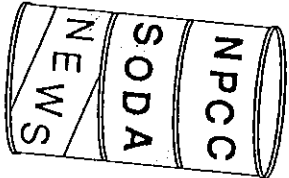

"B A C K T O T H E F U T U R E"

Every collector dreams of making that one find for their collection. I cannot take credit for making this find, however I would like to share with the membership what was discovered in my hometown of Rockford, Illinois earlier this summer.

As reported on August 5, 1991 in the ROCKFORD REGISTER STAR by reporter Spencer Hunt, after a fire gutted the Lillian's women's clothing store at 216 Seventh Street on November 30, 1989, nearly two years later the building was finally demolished. To everyone's surprise, painted on the outer north wall of the building, to the south displayed a Coca-Cola advertisement. Hidden between the buildings for several years from the Midwestern climate, much of the original color is still intact from the green background that contains "Delicious and Refreshing" to the red background that surrounds the all to familiar "Coca-Cola" script trade-mark. Smoke from the fire did blacken a portion of the "Sold Everywhere 5c" but to the trained eye, the lettering can still be made out. Other features include the register trade-mark in the tail of the Coca "C" and in the lower left hand corner the name "Thos Cusack Co., Chicago"

The uniqueness of this discovery is the advertisement contains the slogan "Relieves Fatigue." According to Laura Jester, at the Coca-Cola Company's Archives Department, this ad appeared no later than 1907. A similar ad was uncovered in Newnan, Georgia in May of 1977 after a condemned grocery was torn down by a city crew. Besides the Newnan sign, Coca-Cola has no records of another found with much of its original color intact.

It is believed that the reason Coca-Cola dropped the slogan "Relieves Fatigue" may have been a 1906 federal law making use and possession of cocaine a felony offense. Cocaine was removed from the cola after the Pure Food and Drug Act became law which was an active ingredient in Coca-Cola and the basis for the soft drink's name according to the Atlanta offices.

The building that this turn of the century sign calls home also houses the Rescue Shoppe, a clothing resale store run by the Rockford Rescue Mission Ministries. Executive Director, Perry Pitney, has expressed interest in restoring the sign since he is a big nostalgia buff. Pitney contacted the Rockford Coca-Cola distributor to see if they would be interested in restoring the sign. Ray McDaniels, who handles the advertisements for the company, said the matter is being reviewed by "upper management."

A few weeks after the original article appeared, a follow-up story appeared in the ROCKFORD REGISTER STAR on August 22. Pitney had received three phone calls concerning the advertisement. One couple, Tim & Belinda Sullivan of Rockford expressed interest in restoring the sign. "I just love this old stuff and I'd hate to see it go to waste," Belinda said.

The Sullivans want to take up a collection among local businesses and interested citizens to raise the money to restore it but they do not know how to organize a fundraiser.

A minimum of \$5000 would be a starting figure according to Sam Vecchio of Sam Vecchio Signs of Rockford. "Anybody can go up there and slap some paint on it, but if you're going to actually restore it, you've got to scrape away the loose (paint) with a wire brush and primer the areas that are bare."

The Rockford Coca-Cola Bottling has expressed they will not take part in the restoration of the sign. Their reasons according to McDaniels, there was an objectionable phrase in the advertisement. He did not say if the slogan "Relieves Fatigue" was the objectionable phrase or not.

I will be keeping the membership updated as additional information becomes available.

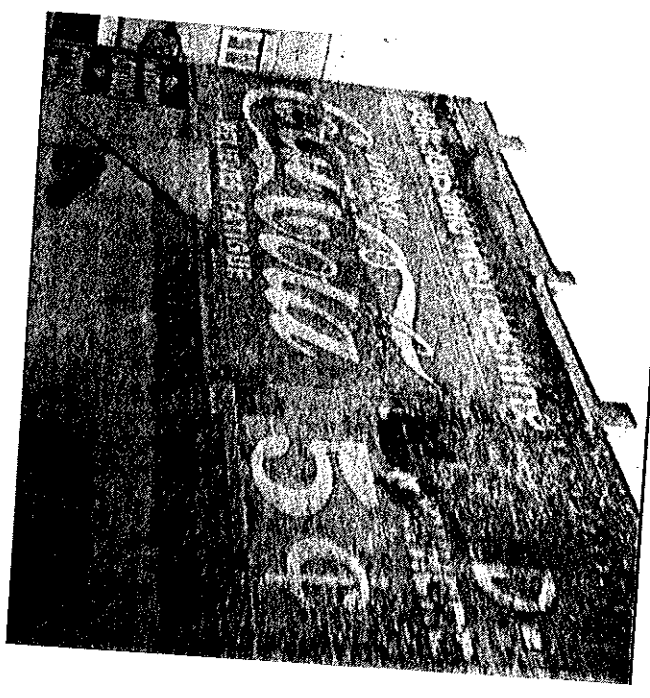

AFTER THIS FLASHBACK, I ASKED MY DAD ABOUT THE PUZZLE. WITHIN A FEW MINUTES, DAD PULLED FROM THE ORIGINAL ENVELOP THE PUZZLE WAS CONTAINED IN NINE CARDBOARD SQUARES. EACH SQUARE WAS NUMBERED 1 THROUGH 9 AND WAS SECTIONED OFF INTO FOUR TRIANGLES. EACH TRIANGLE WAS COLOURED EITHER RED, BLUE, GREEN OR (NOW FADED) WHITE AND PICTURED EITHER A TOP OR BOTTOM HALF OF A VESS COLA BOTTLE. ON THE BACK OF EACH SQUARE CONTAINED ONE OF NINE DIFFERENT ADVERTISEMENTS FOR EITHER VESS OR THE PUZZLE.

ON THE FRONT OF THE ENVELOP, THE VESS COLA LOGO IS PRINTED ALONG WITH DIRECTIONS FOR THE "MYSTERY PUZZLE." PRINTED ON THE BACK ARE INSTRUCTIONS TO SEND AWAY FOR THE ANSWER/SOLUTION TO THE PUZZLE.

DAD DOESN'T REMEMBER HOW GRANDPA GOT THE PUZZLES; HE BELIEVES HE SENT AWAY FOR IT. NOR DOES HE REMEMBER EXACTLY WHEN HE OBTAINED IT, BUT DAD CAN PLACE IT AROUND THE MID TO LATE 1940'S.

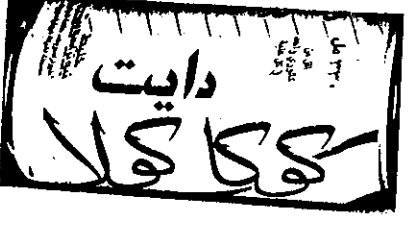
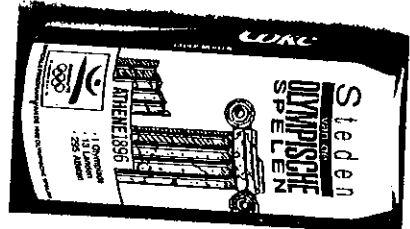
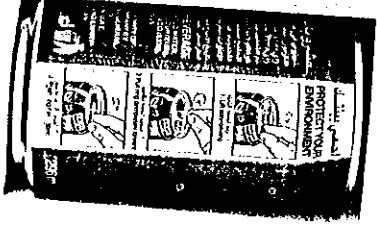
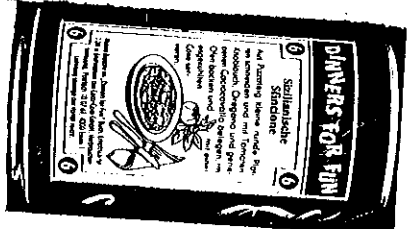
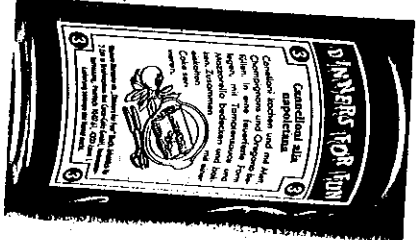
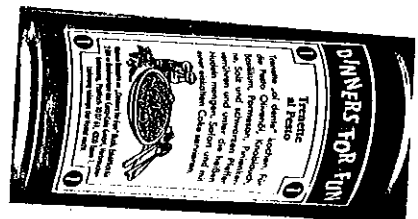
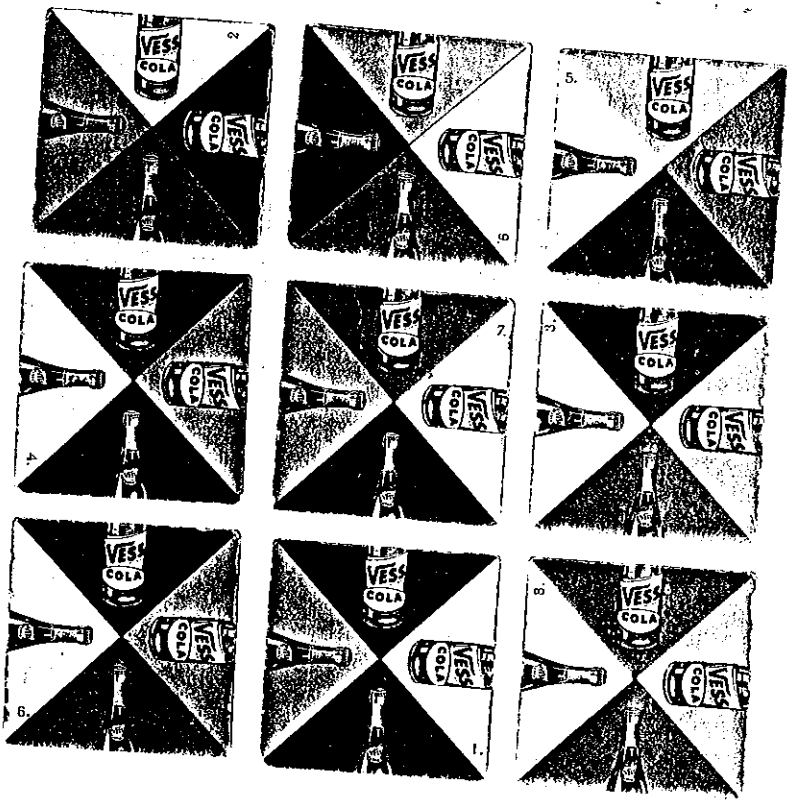
